**Yaksh** is an Online Test Interface for creating various courses and conducting online programming quizzes. It supports various programming languages like :- C, C++, Python and simple Bash. User can solve any questions by using these languages. Yaksh uses "test cases" to test the the implementations of the students. It also supports simple multiple choice questions and file uploads so that user can easily submit his code.

### 1.1 Vision

1. Creating a new look i.e., UI and improving UX of the website on the Student's side.

# Chapter 2

## Detected issues and relevant Solutions

These are the changes that are made to the YAKSH website on the Student's side, considering the issues and keeping in mind the goal to solve them.

(NOTE: I refers to the issue and C refers to the change)

### 2.1 Common elements on most of the pages

#### 1. Top Navigation Bar:

- **Login page:**

I: No nav-bar

C: Added ABOUT US, CONTACT links along with YAKSH logo that redirects to home page always.

- **Registration page:**

I: No nav-bar, home redirecting link is somewhere at the bottom of the page.

C: Added Login Instead link along with YAKSH logo that redirects to home page always.

- **Exam page:**

I: No issue C: Improved alignment of nav-items

- **Error pages and Confirmation/ Redirecting pages:**

I: No nav-bar. User finds difficulty in going back to home page

C: Added YAKSH Logo that redirects to home page.

- **Other pages:**

I: Too many user activities links on nav-bar, Separate home link is missing.

C: My profile, Change Password and Logout options are added under username dropdown, Added home link that redirects to Student's dashboard page.

## 2. Footer:

- **Login Page:**

I: No issue C: Added Fork us, FOSSEE website links along with Email id

- **Other pages:**

I: Missing contact mail id for queries

C: Added the same

## 3. Sidebar:

- **Videos page:**

I: No proper mobile view, togglable icons

C: Made side-bar mobile-responsive. It is collapsed by default in mobile view and on click, it expands. Changed togglable icons

- **Exam page:**

I: Missing info regarding what type of questions are present in exam. Syllabus links can redirect user to another page and can divert the user from quiz. Becomes an issue if the user doesn't understand how to get back to quiz page

C: Added info regarding: List of Type of questions with question numbers referring to the type. Removed syllabus from sidebar

## 2.2 Page wise issues and solutions

### 1. Login Page:

I: Missing website statistics

C: Include: Stats like x number of students in x number of institutions across x states are using YAKSH, 'About Us' information from YAKSH-GitHub Docs, Change position of Sign up button

### 2. Courses Dashboard Page

I: No proper display of categorised courses list, Missing syllabus/overview of course –Student cannot view syllabus unless he/she enrolls, Missing START course button –Student doesn't know he/she has to click on course name to start course

C: Respective list of courses can be viewed under particular category, Change ENROLL button to START/RESUME course button once user has enrolled, Include DETAILS button to view course details page. Under details expansion include all the course related info on course details page like: What you'll learn, Instructor, Requirements and Side label containing extra info like: Start and end dates, Level, Perks

### 3. Course Modules Page

I: Students cannot understand the lessons/quizzes link and module link.

C: Put all the module units status and answer paper link in collapse with a caret icon. Include Start/Resume button for each module.

#### 4. Quiz Page

I: Question and its related information like marks, question type is not properly arranged.

C: Properly align all the question related information. Question number and question can be to the left, type of question and marks can be to the right.

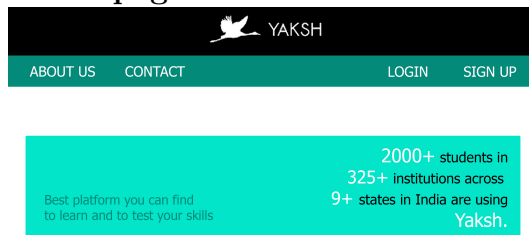



## Implementation

### 4.1 Used Tech Stack:

- Version Upgrades:  
Bootstrap v3 to v4  
jquery v1 to v3
- Additional files:  
popper.js (required by some of Bootstrap v4 classes)  
animate.css (for animations)  
wow.js (for making animations dynamic)
- Custom css written exclusively for YAKSH:  
yakshcustom.css  
Classes starting with prefix yaksh indicate classes belonging to this custom css.

The previous YAKSH templates were written using Bootstrap v3. The new design of the website is implemented by changing almost 80 percentage of the code using html tags, css classes and django template tags. Use of JS and inline-css is mostly avoided.

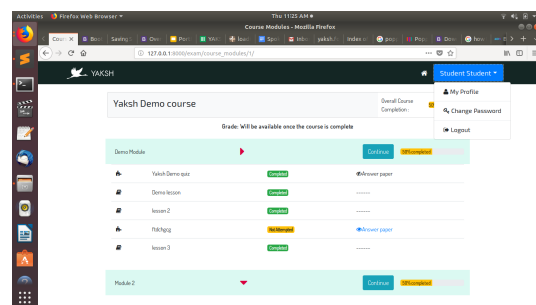
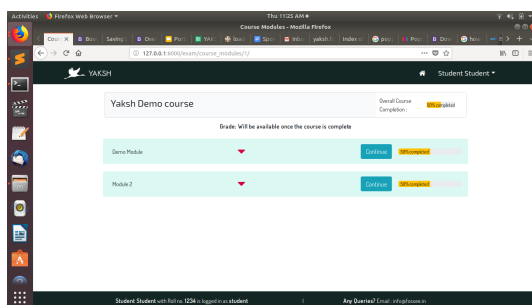
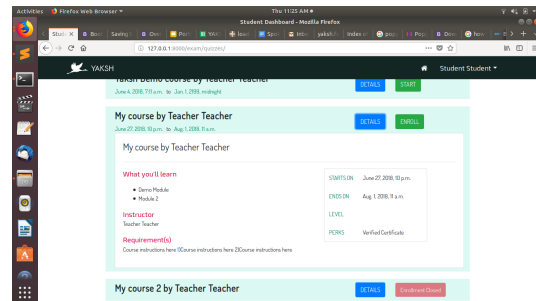
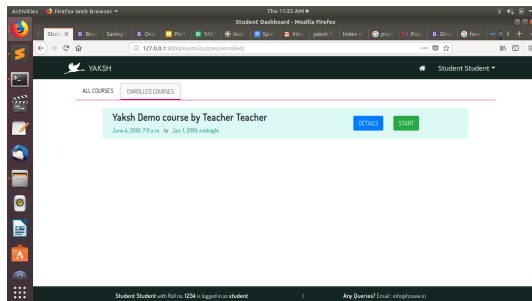
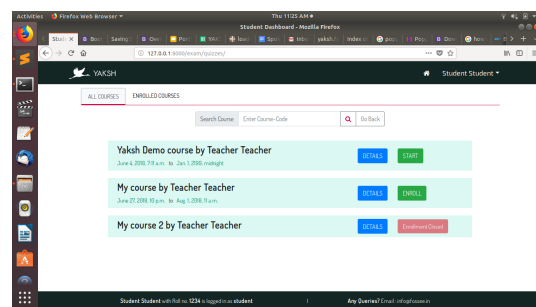
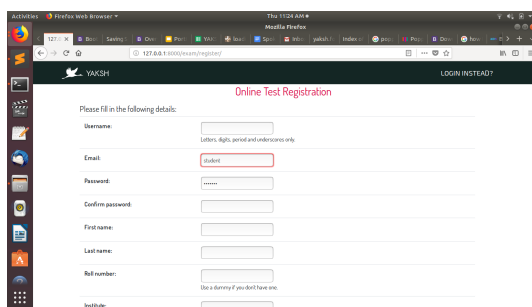
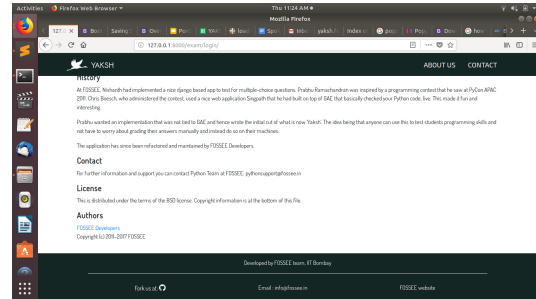
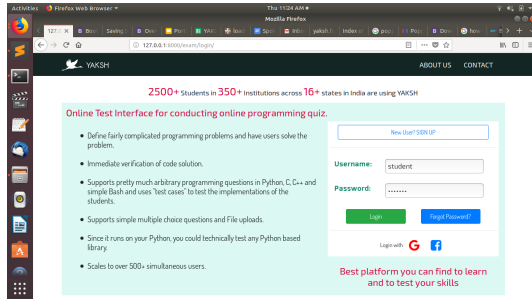

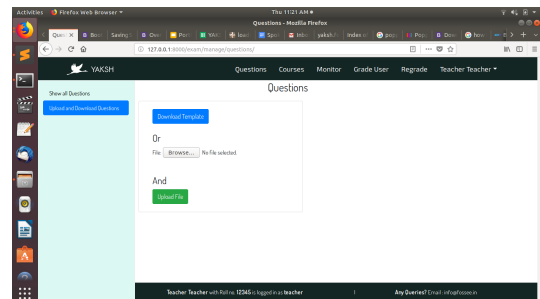
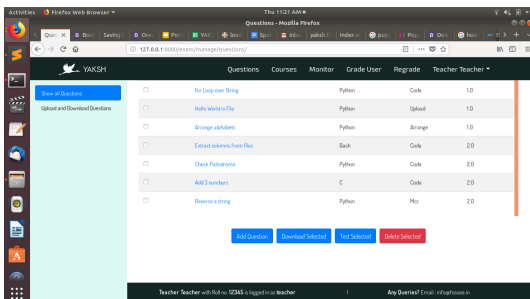
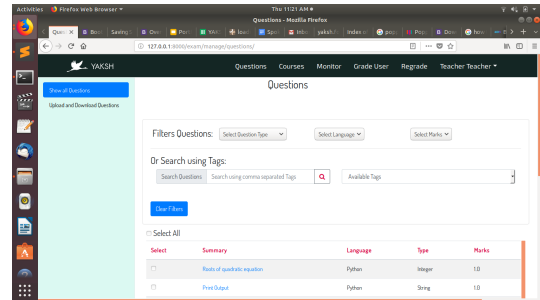
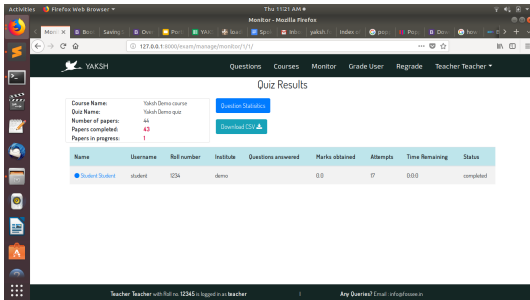
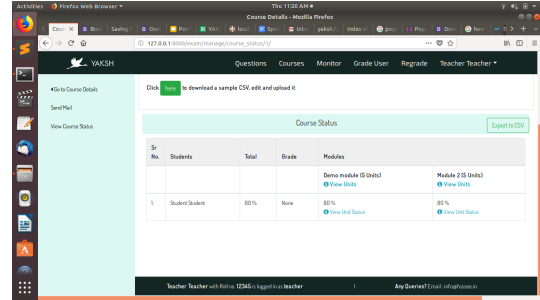
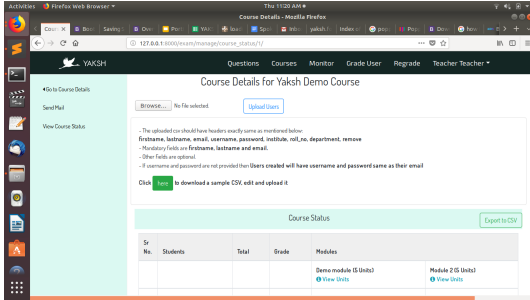
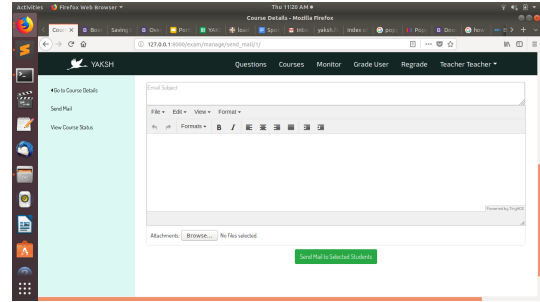
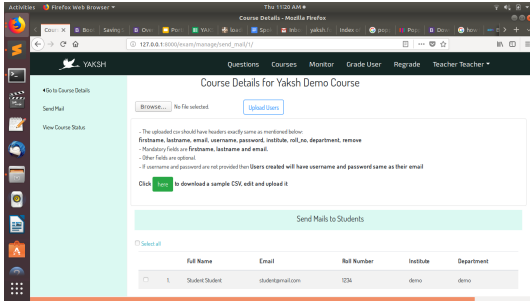
Long tables are now made to fit in fixed height and are vertically scrollable. User need not scroll the entire page to reach to other buttons/ elements on the page.

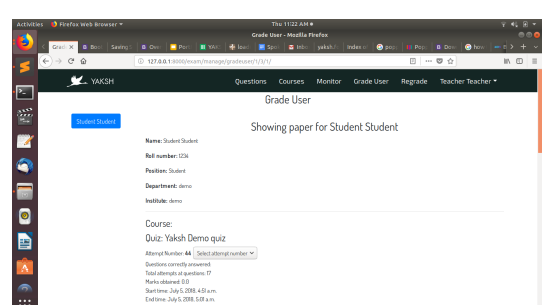
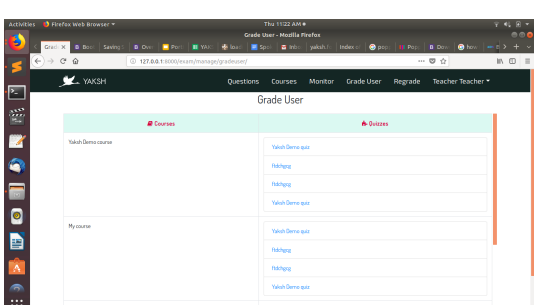
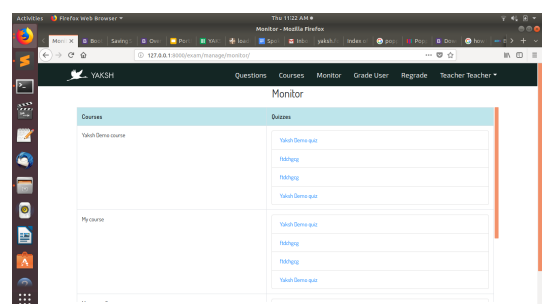
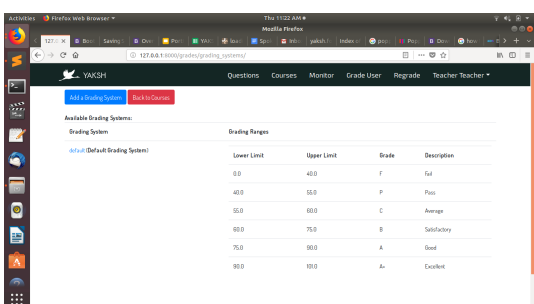
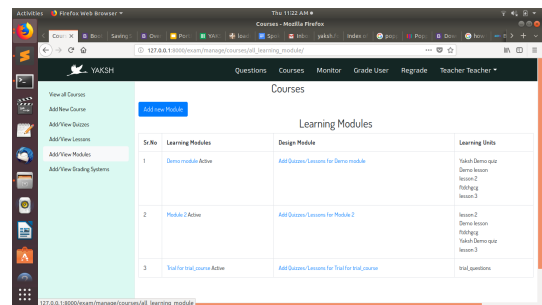
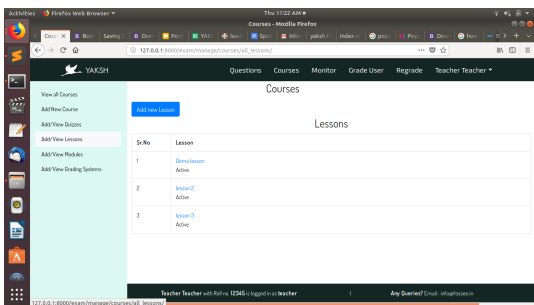
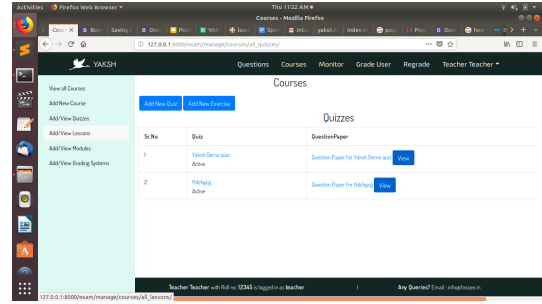
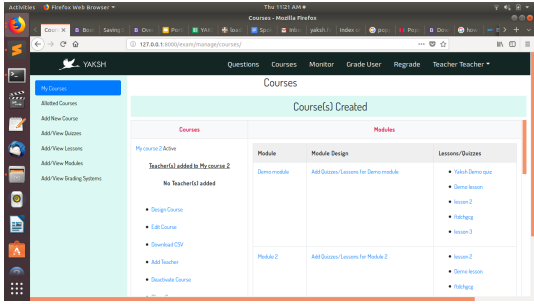
### Mobile-view
