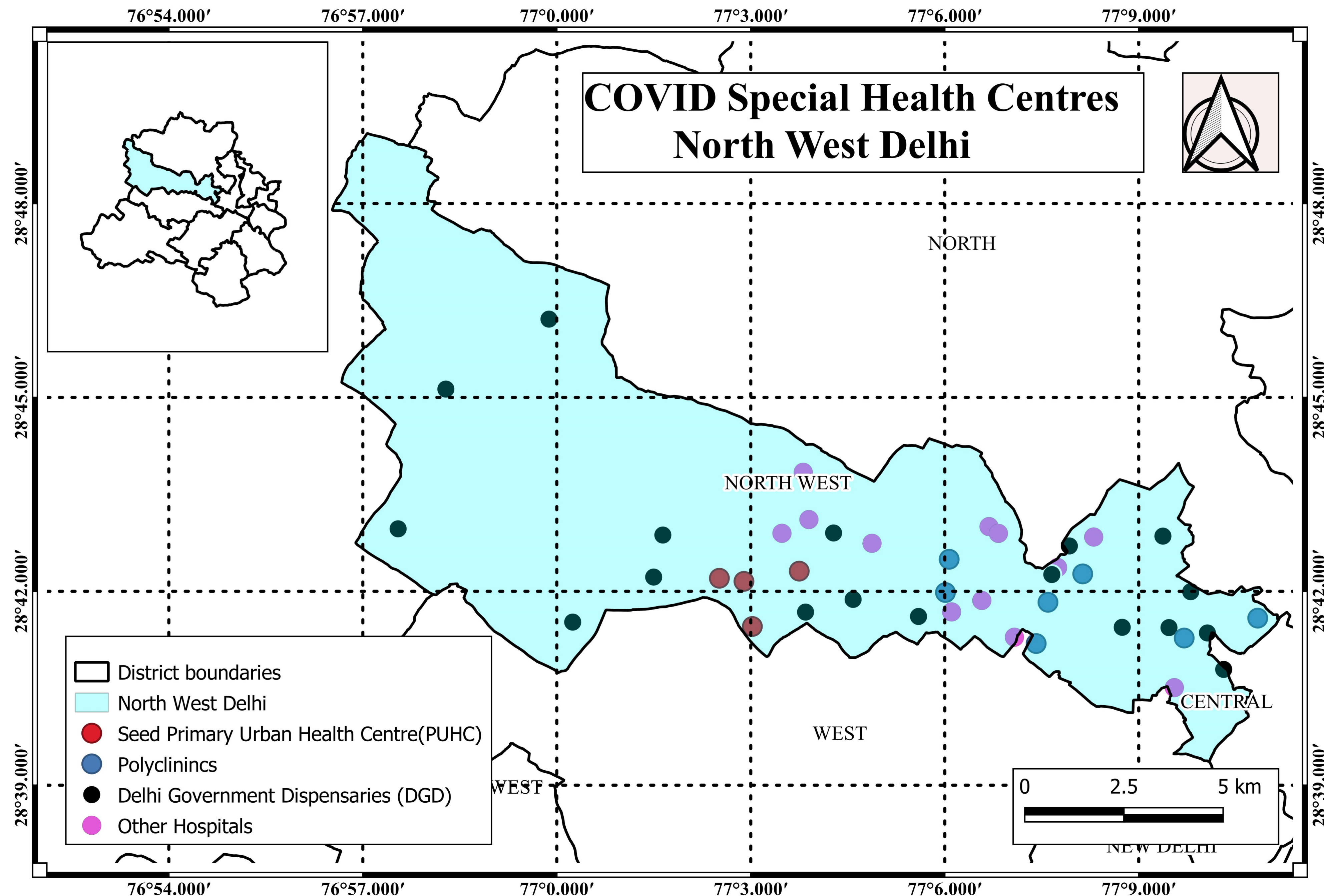


Title: COVID Special Health Centres in North-West Delhi

Map description and analysis



Introduction:

New Delhi, The National Capital of India, is divided into 11 districts, 33 sub-divisions, 59 census towns and 300 villages, according to census 2011. There has been severe increase in the number of corona cases in this region due to several factors. Thus, need for Health centres become essential. This map presents the various types of Health centres located in the region of North-West Delhi, which are used for COVID related operations. These are the analysis of four different types of centres -

Seed Primary Urban Health Centre (PUHC):

- There are 5 PUHC located in North-West Delhi named as Prem Nagar II, Prem Nagar III, Pratap Vihar and Inder Enclave

Polyclinics:

- There are 8 Polyclinics present in this region, mostly located in the South-West side of the region.

Delhi Government Dispensaries:

- 21 DGDs are present in the region

Other Hospitals:

- 16 Hospitals are spread across the regions, which offers COVID related health facilities.

Maximum number of health centres are located within the Rohini and Saraswati Vihar Tehsil.
