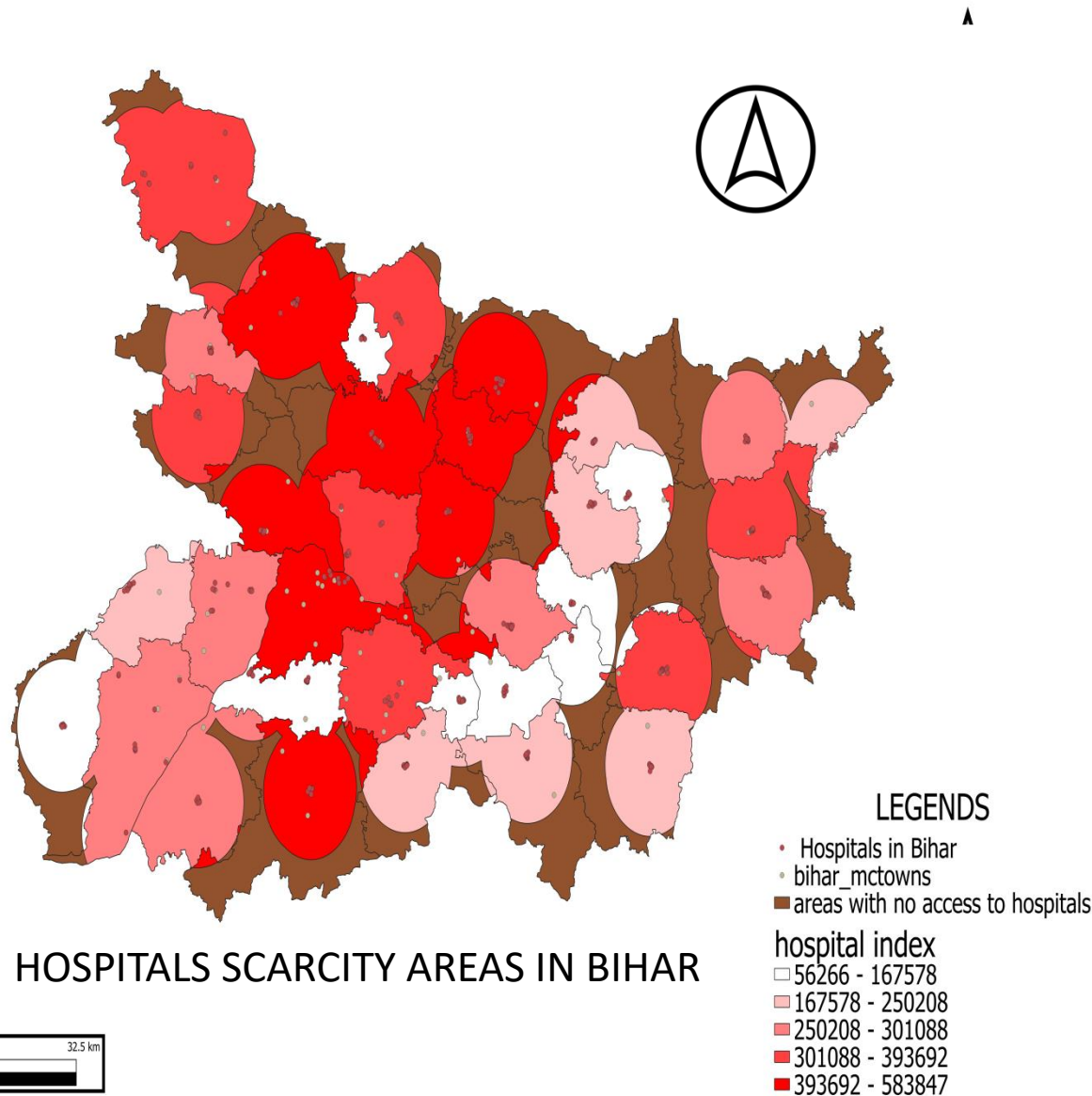


# POSSIBILITIES FOR HEALTH CARE FACILITIES IN BIHAR

### Healthcare and facilities:

### Current Posture :

- Population density of 1160 person per sq.m
- overall system never develop enough to meet the needs of growing population
- National Rural Health mission (NRHM) 2005 infused resources into the system but did not make significant changes in the system
- At district level care facilities cater about to 3 million people each giving rise to more challenges
- the major health care demographic indicator of state infant mortality rate 42% and maternal mortality rate up to 16%

### Inference:

- lack of primary health care centers and hospitals leads to the problems in the system
- there should be sufficient hospital facilities according to the population of the region
- Here in this mapping we tried to find the areas with no nearby access to the hospitals
- with which it is easy to build network of health facilities in required area
