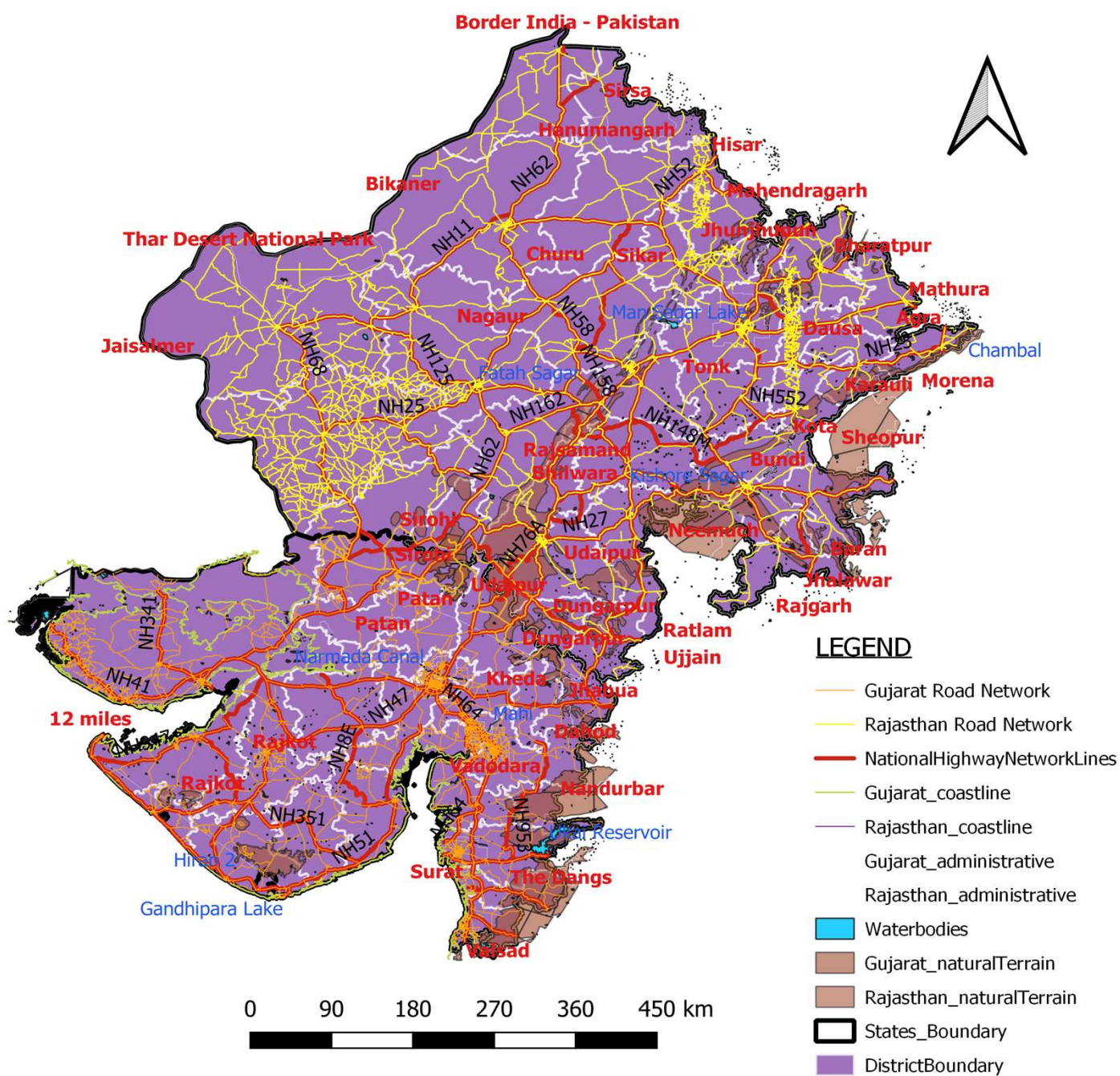


Title: National Highway Map of Gujarat and Rajasthan



Map description and analysis

Introduction:

- The State of Gujarat is well known for its booming trade sector. The construction of new National Highway infrastructure such as the Bharuch Bridge has strengthened socio economic ties with neighbouring States.
- Rajasthan state has a good road network which plays an important role for agriculture, commerce, safety, education and social welfare. On 31 March 1951, Rajasthan has a road network of 17339kms & it grew to 2,64,244kms till date.

Road hierarchy:

- In Gujarat, 2,547 km of National Highways have been developed through 39 major and minor projects. The length of National Highways have reached 7,873 km.
- Rajasthan has 47 National Highways with total length of 9998.80(30-11-2018). 18 km and 85 State Highways with total length of 11,756 km. The NH-8 is the most famous national highway in the state which joins Ajmer-Jaipur-Udaipur-Chittorgarh and also the oldest one in the country with 4-8 lanes. NH-8 length is around 688 kms in the Rajasthan state.

Road Network Details:

- Jodhpur District of Rajasthan has maximum length of roads while Dholpur District has minimum length.
- Rajasthan has the 3rd highest length of National Highways.
- The road Density of Rajasthan is 77.21km per 100sq.km whereas of Gujarat is around 38 km per 100 sq.km.

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
